Please read the following carefully. You MUST complete this entire application in order to be considered for a park permit. Failure to do so will cause your application to be rejected.

1. A copy of your dog's current town license paperwork (example: if the calendar year is 2015 then you must send 2015 town license paperwork) which includes:
  - (1) Current proof that your dog is either spayed or neutered (IF not indicated on item #1 above, you MUST enclose separate documentation copy of such altering).
  - (2) Rabies expiration date. Your dog must be current on it Rabies vaccination at time of application. Again, if not indicated on license, a separate document will be required.
2. A self-addressed stamped envelope. There is no picking up of the tags and permits.
3. A signed original copy of this application.

Please read and initial below:

- ✓ Failure to provide any one or combination of items at the time of application will result in the application being rejected.
- ✓ The Animal Control Officer has up to 30 days to process my application, and every effort to get my tag and permit to me sooner will be made.
- ✓ I am not allowed to enter and use the Medway Dog Park UNTIL I have received my tag and permit.
- ✓ There are rules and regulations for using Medway's dog Park and I agree to follow and abide by the rules and regulations.
- ✓ Use of Medway's Dog Park is a privilege and failure to follow the rules will result in either a temporary suspension of my park privileges or a permanent revocation of my privileges.
